The season of lent continues! On March 31, we'll hear the story of "The Prodigal Son" from a different point of view. April 7 shares the story of the woman who anointed the feet of Jesus. During this service, we will have the opportunity to share communion, and anoint and pray for each other.

<u>Palm Sunday - April 14:</u> Come join in the celebration as we open the service, waving palm branches and singing "Hosanna!" During the service, we will begin the journey toward the passion as we hear the story of Holy Week as presented in the book of Mark. As the service progresses, the story will be heard, and the sanctuary will be stripped of all adornments. The congregation will be asked to leave in silence at the end of the service. Coffee and refreshments will be served out on the patio that morning.

<u>Good Friday - April 19:</u> The church sanctuary will be opened from 12:00 - 3:00 pm, and there will be scripture readings and prayerful meditations available for any who would like to come and spend some time reflecting on this powerful, poignant part of the story of the death of Jesus. Members of the Worship Committee will be at the church to make sure the doors are open, and all are welcome to come and spend some time in quiet meditation.

Easter, April 21

Sunrise Service - 6:15 am: Greet the dawn of this Easter morning as we gather to worship up in the Sunrise Area at 6:15 am. Plan to dress warmly and bring a blanket to sit on, and join with others as we once again hear the miraculous story of the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ! Following the service, there will be an Easter Sunday brunch served in the sanctuary, with hot coffee, tea, and cocoa, cinnamon rolls, fruit, juice, and other treats. Easter Worship - 10:00 am: All are welcome to join in the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord at the 10:00 am worship service. Join us for wonderful music, stirring hymns, and joy filled proclamations of "He is risen! He is risen indeed!" Invite your friends, neighbors, and families to this service of hope and excitement! The Community Life/Action Committee will be providing the reception after church on this morning, and there will be an Easter "Goody Table" provided by Worship Committee.
