Lease Update: Keller Williams, our commercial leasing agent, brought a proposal to the Trustees for leasing a portion of the downstairs. The Trustees created a lease, had that lease reviewed by Legal counsel at the Presbytery of San Francisco, updated Session, and then forwarded the draft lease to Keller Williams. We have heard back from the prospective tenant and are now answering some resulting questions. We are hopeful we will soon have a new tenant at Bethany.

Kathryn Pyke's Resignation Update: A congregational meeting was held after the service on June 28 for the members to vote on the Dissolution of the Terms of Pastor Kathryn Pyke's call and her severance package. The meeting was moderated by Rev. Janet Bower from the Presbytery's Committee on Ministries. The vote was a simple majority in favor of accepting the Dissolution of Pastor Kathryn Pyke's call and her severance package. Kathryn's last day in the pulpit was July 28, with her last official day with Bethany Church on July 31, 2019. Severance payments will begin in August, 2019.

Other Trustee Updates: George Lynch from the Personnel Committee has secured pulpit supply for August and September. The Trustees, along with Session, will be reviewing and assisting in a further draft statement of Interim Pastor job requirements. The Presbytery's Committee on Ministries will assist Bethany after Pastor Kathryn's departure and the Rev. Janet Bower has committed to being available for any questions. Assistance on other items needing attention will be provided by the Session and various Session committees, such as Personnel and Worship.

K. Mitchell led the Devotion reflecting on the words of Be Thou My Vision.

Rev. Bower explained the Presbytery's outline for Exit Interview which has been completed with Rev. K. Pyke and will be conducted with BPC Elders at the next meeting.

This interview will present the Session with an opportunity to discuss: *where the congregation has been and where it is today. *the relationship between the departing pastor and the congregation. *the strengths and weaknesses of the congregation. *challenges the congregation is facing or will face during the transition.

BPC Elders & Deacons will complete a 6 hour Communication Training on Saturday, August 24, 2019.

L. Hughes reported for Financial Trustees that at 1/2 year faithful giving is continuing.

Draft lease proposal for a portion of our downstairs to a Sikh congregation has been approved by Presbytery and will possibly be implemented as soon as Sept. 1, 2019.

G. Lynch has secured Pulpit Supply Pastors for BPC through Sept. 2019 with the hope an Interim Pastor will be named by October.

K. Mitchell and Rev. Bower will research possibilities of ways to employ a Pastor or Seminarian to lead Bible Study classes.

Community Life will host August 1st Saturday Dinner with Summer Movie Night on 8/3/19 with pizza, salad & make-your-own-sundaes.

K. Quickert will host the October 1st Saturday event (10/5/19) with a Potluck Picnic at Junipero Serra Park, complete with beloved BPC Sno-Cones!

Rev. Janet Bower will provide Pastoral Care for BPC, with assistance from Rev. InHo Kim and Rev. Robin Crawford, until an Interim Pastor is secured.
