

Christmas for Catholic Worker Hospitality House (CWHH) - Peter Stiehler, Director of CWHH, was contacted in the last week of November to request gift ideas for those in need at his facility. Again this year, Peter came through with lists of items

needed, which included gift cards. Tags were hung on our beautiful Bethany tree and all 24 tags were fulfilled; similar to the HelpOneChild effort, all gift donations were delivered to the church by the December 17 deadline. Many thanks to the Bethany Deacons who contributed \$500 which was spent on 26 gift cards. There were also toothbrushes and toothpaste, men's thermal shirts, T-shirts, socks, soap and washcloths, other various toiletries, men's sweatshirts, hats and gloves, men's underwear, etc. In total there were 42 gift cards and 5 large boxes of gifts delivered to CWHH by December 18. Thanks to all of you who participated. Your generosity, thoughtfulness, and the care you showed to those in our community this year was outstanding!

Building and Grounds Issues

- 1. We have been advised that we need to replace our antiquated electrical panel for maximum efficiency. Next steps: 1: Update electrical panel, 2: Decide on solar energy panels/installation, and 3: Install heat pump.
- 2. Room 9 clean-up: The desk drawers have been removed from the oak desk in Rm 9 and the desk itself will be removed soon. The two pianos and some items in the downstairs storage room still need to be hauled away.
- 3. The Kitchen Update Committee met and made a wish list of work needed and desired items for our outdated kitchen. Next steps in January include calling a consultant for a walkthrough about what might be done at what cost (note: the kitchen island and the cabinets are of great concern). The Kitchen Committee scheduled a kitchen cleanup day on January 22, 2024 at 10am.
- 4. Patio Repair: on hold until 2024.
- 5. Upper Roof Repair: on hold until 2024.
- 6. The Sanctuary was painted by Craig Bray and his team in early December. Thanks go out to Craig and his team for a job well done in a very short time.
- 7. On-line giving opportunities: This information is still being processed as there is some discussion about how the Wells Fargo Bank instructions can be implemented.
- 8. The Global Witness and Peacemaking offering was wrapped up for 2023. \$205.25 remained at Bethany Church and \$615.75 was sent to Presbyterian Church USA.
- 9. The annual Stewardship Drive has been completed and dedicated. The 2024 Budget is being finalized by the Financial Trustees and will be presented to Session for approval. There are a few 2024 pledge cards still missing.
- 10. A new color copier was leased and put into place through Copy Tech. This replaces our current old, black and white copier.
- 11. Our four staff members, Pastor Deb, Jessica, Cathleen, and Kathryn received a separate 2023 bonus payment in addition to their December 15, 2023 paychecks. Salary and other benefit updates are still being discussed, but should be finalized in preparation for implementation in 2024.
