Lease Update:

Keller Williams, our commercial leasing agent, brought a proposal to the Trustees for leasing a portion of the downstairs. The Trustees responded with some questions and challenges to the proposal and we are now awaiting feedback from Keller Williams once they contact the prospective tenant.

Kathryn Pyke's Resignation Update:

The Trustees met with InHo Kim from the Presbytery of San Francisco on May 24 and finalized a resignation date and several package details for Pastor Kathryn. The package was then brought to the Session on June 18 and the Session voted to take the package to the congregation members for approval on June 28.

At the Session "Minutes" meeting on June 21, written details of Kathryn Pyke's resignation date and severance package were provided to those in attendance at the meeting and details reviewed with Lyn Hughes and Tamra Hollenbeck from the Session. Several questions were answered.

A congregational meeting will be held after the service on June 28 for the members to vote on the Dissolution of the Terms of Pastor's Kathryn Pyke's call and her severance package. The vote will be a simple majority. If the resignation date and severance package are not approved, the package will go back to the Trustees for updating and the process will restart after any required updates are made, i.e. Session will need to approve again and another congregational meeting will need to be called.

Other Trustee Updates:

At our June 17th meeting, the Trustees also discussed pulpit supply, beginning a draft of Interim Pastor requirements, and assistance that will be provided by the Presbytery's Committee on Ministries after Kathryn's departure. Assistance on these items will also be provided, as needed, by the Session and various Session committees such as Personnel and Worship.
