
October will also begin a two month study of the letter to the Hebrews. The challenge that comes with the book of Hebrews is that many times the texts are used out of context to malign our Jewish brothers and sisters. Much of the language of Hebrews seems to imply that Christianity is better than, and has superseded the Jewish faith. We know now that it's not that simple, and Christ was the fulfillment of, not the replacement for, all of the beauty and wisdom of the Old Testament and its teachings. I hope you can join us for this thoughtful series.

World Communion/Peacemaking Sunday

On the first Sunday in October, October 6, we will celebrate World Communion Sunday, when we acknowledge the relationship to all our sisters and brothers in Christ worldwide. We will honor the diversity of our faith by including breads from all over the world as part of the communion sacrament. Also on October 6, we will launch the Peace and Global Witness Offering, a special offering of the Presbyterian Church, a way of continuing the ancient Christian practice of sharing what we have with people in need. A letter will be sent to the congregation at the end of September with more details. Bethany is allowed to retain 25% of this offering to use in a way to promote peacemaking in our community. The rest of the funds go to the Presbytery and the General Assembly for their peacemaking work locally and abroad.
