Lease Update:

Keller Williams continues their work for us regarding the prospective tenant. The tenant has confirmed they are indeed interested in leasing our downstairs classroom space (please note Room 9 is not part of the lease). However, some building modifications may be needed and a structural engineer is being hired by the tenant with KW's assistance in order to ensure any modifications would work for our space. We are moving forward and hope to have the lease signed soon.

Kathryn Pyke Information Update:

On July 31, 2019, our former pastor, Kathryn Pyke, was paid one month's vacation pay, which was her accumulated vacation balance on our records, as well as the first severance payment due to her of a possible six payments. The vacation and severance payments were completed as separate direct deposits so as to not create any confusion or questions. We will continue to pay our former pastor severance payments from September 2019 through January 2020 (with assistance from the Presbytery of San Francisco) unless Rev. Pyke finds a job in the Grand Canyon Presbytery in Arizona.

Other Trustee or Committee Updates Involving the Trustees:

- George Lynch from the Personnel Committee has secured pulpit supply for September and is now working on October
- The Session has started a review of a draft for Interim/Transitional Pastor job requirements and qualities. Further work will continue in future Session meetings which are being moderated by Rev. Janet Bower
- George Lynch received a job application from Jessica Reddell, our current accompanist, for our Music Director/Leader position. The Trustees reviewed Ms. Reddell's application, which included salary and vacation requirements as well as a statement clarifying the position duties. George then presented the Trustees' response to Ms. Reddell's requirements and Ms. Reddell accepted and agreed to our terms and conditions. The first choir rehearsal is scheduled to be on Wednesday, September 4th.
