Free Covid-19 At-Home Tests now Available: You can now order free at-home tests through the USPS! There's a limit of one order (4 tests) per residential address. These are rapid antigen tests – no lab required, results in approx. 30 minutes. You can go directly to the USPS site to order them: <https://special.usps.com/testkits>

In addition, if you purchase at-home tests after January 15th, your health insurance company is required to reimburse you. Check with your insurance company for details.

Prayer from 1/30/2022

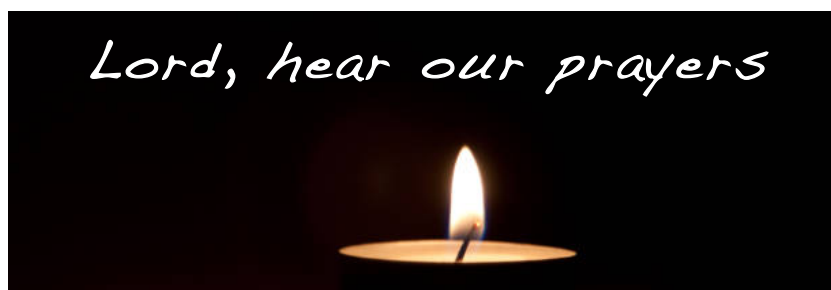
- Prayers for Craig's mil Lupita, who has entered hospice care, and prayers for the whole family in this time (Craig Bray)
