#### **Worship Committee Announcements**

Ash Sunday - March 10: This year, the Worship Committee has decided to try something a little different. Instead of Ash Wednesday, which is traditionally marked on the Wednesday before the first Sunday of Lent, we will be starting our Lenten Journey with the disposition of ashes as part of our worship service on Sunday, March 10. The ashes are prepared each year using several of the palm branches that were waved in church during the previous year's Palm Sunday, and those ashes will be used to mark us a children of God and followers of Christ.

**Fresh Fruit for March 10:** For this first Sunday in Lent, we are asking the congregation to bring fresh fruit - oranges, apples, bananas, grapes, kiwis, etc - to adorn the communion table as a symbol of abundance and delight. All the fruit will then be taken to the Shelter to be used during the breakfasts served on weekdays. Please bring any fresh fruit to the sanctuary for worship on Sunday, March 10, and thank you in advance!

<u>Food Collection for San Bruno Shelter:</u> Sunday, March 10 also marks the start of our food and supplies collection for the San Bruno Shelter. Please bring non perishable food items and any other supplies as requested by the Shelter Ministry Committee. Those items will be dedicated on Palm Sunday, April 14, and sent to the shelter to help our sisters and brothers in need.

**Lenten Liturgical Art:** The sanctuary will be reconfigured during the season of Lent as a way to mark the sacredness of the season. There will be banners and other items on the communion table that also will reflect a lenten theme.

<u>Elder Visits to Congregation</u>: On February 3, the congregational meeting brought to light that there are a lot of feelings and concerns about Bethany. Session discussed this at length at our February meeting, and it was decided that we need to get in touch with the congregation, to check in and to hear from you. Six elders - Lyn Hughes, Tamra Hollenbeck, George Lynch, Pam Matthews, Kathleen Mitchell, and Roxane Wales - have agreed to call upon members and friends of Bethany, to offer an opportunity for honest sharing of your hopes and vision for the future of our church. We hope to make visits to most of you during the month of March, and if you haven't heard from us and want to share your thoughts, please contact one of us or let Rev. Kathryn know, and we'll schedule a visit. The goal is to bring about some reconciliation and healing so we can move forward, open and ready to continue doing the work of God in the world. Thank you in advance for allowing us to visit, and may the peace of Christ be with you each and every moment.

<u>Rev. Richard Pyke will lead the Monday Bible Study</u> beginning March 11 - April 15. We will be using scripture lessons dealing with Lent, leading up to Holy Week. We meet on Mondays from 12 noon to 1 p.m.
