Session Meeting Highlights Tuesday, May 24, 2022

The meeting was held via Zoom. It was opened with the lighting of the Christ Candle and a prayer by Rev. Deb at 7:10 pm. Deb led a devotion with this message: "The evil in the world cannot be allowed to dwell within. Look around for God. The things that sustain us are still all around us."

Reports:

Clerk of Session:

- Minutes of the April 26, 2022 meeting were approved as presented.
- Kent Sicklebower, former long-time member at Bethany, died on May 19.
 Congregation was notified via Deacons.

Financial Trustees:

- Once again, we are solvent.
- The Benevolence Grant of \$2000 from Presbytery will be going into the General Giving to be used as things come up.
- The Trustees are setting up a brokerage account to receive some stocks from the Bullis Foundation.

Buildings and Grounds:

- The wood for stair replacement of the steps down to the Sikh entrance has been purchased.
- The new disposal for the kitchen has been purchased. Dave is seeking assistance in replacing it.

Worship:

- A new rainbow flag has been purchased to replace the current one on Pentecost Sunday, June 5.
- A discussion regarding current masking protocol was held. Session continues to advise we keep current protocols in place because of the increase in Covid cases.
- Pride Sunday will be on June 26.

Pastor's Report:

- The Festival of Homelitics study leave was amazing and very enjoyable.
- Questions were raised about the Sikh communities' flying of several American flags on the walkway down to their area. Deb will discuss the idea of separation of Church and State with the Sikh leaders.
- A discussion was held about ideas for outreach to the community, making Bethany a known presence.

Other Business:

- Choir's last Sunday for the season will be Father's Day, June 19. Prayz will
 continue to provide music during the summer as they are able to.
- Bethany By-laws need to be reviewed and updated.
- The Deacon's will host a Start of the Summer luncheon after worship on 6/26. There will also be an opportunity for the congregation to send 4th of July greetings to those who are not able to be in worship regularly.
- Personnel: Deb will be away on study leave and vacation beginning June 26 (after worship) through July 12. The first week will be study leave, and the second week will be vacation.
- Next meeting date: Tuesday, June 21, 2022 via Zoom.
