Guidelines for In-Person Gathering Bethany Presbyterian Church Beginning September 12, 2021

It is with great joy we announce that we will be opening for in-person worship on September 12, 2021. In keeping with State and local guidelines, and CDC guidelines, we are posting this protocol for entry into our building. The space is deep cleaned once each week. Hand sanitizer is available. **Proof of vaccination is required.**

General

- -Open for those fully vaccinated unless medically contraindicated (**proof of vaccination is required**)
- -Please keep doors open for maximum air circulation
- -Properly fitting masks must be worn while indoors
- -Maintain distance from others

10:00am Sunday Worship Service

- -Open to all fully vaccinated people unless medically contraindicated (**proof of vaccination is required**)
- -Please remain masked
- -Please sit at a distance from other parishioners
- -No touching greet one another creatively!
- -Singing is allowed while masked only
- -Food to be eaten outside only
- -Post- and pre-worship visiting outside only
