Session will meet again on Monday, to determine the time line for additional restrictions.

If you have not already provided your offering for March or are wondering about how to provide your April offering, please mail it to the church so we can make a deposit(s) over the next few weeks to make sure our staff are paid and bills are kept current. We thank you in advance for your faithful giving during this unusual time.

Isolation is one of the hardest things for so many people of any age. We are working to do everything we can to reach out to everyone. Please call pastor Deb with any needs or concerns and we will all try our best to be there for each other. This decision was very difficult for all of us. We know that not having worship is more than an inconvenience. We are here for you.


