Give Thanks to God Who Hears Our Cries

(Psalm 107)



- 5 If you have felt your courage fail before a violent sea and cried to God, who stilled the storm, and made the wild wind flee, then in the congregation praise the One who heard your plea.
- So praise the One whose love is great, whose kindness is well-known.
 Consider well the healing hand and help you have been shown, and tell the world what God has done.
 Praise God and God alone!

The singing of psalm paraphrases is the most long-standing musical practice in Reformed tradition, dating from John Calvin's own congregation in Geneva in the 16th century. This recent paraphrase of Psalm 107 illustrates the interpretive flexibility that is a hallmark of the form.
